Celebrations - fireworks, bang, whizz, crash, colour names

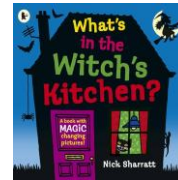
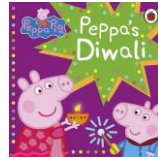

Phonics

Rhythm and rhyme –
We will read a variety
of stories that rhyme.

Key knowledge and skills this half term

Maths – Count 3 objects. Recite numbers to 5. Compare groups – more/fewer. Recognise and talk about patterns. Build with 3D shapes.

Language – Sing songs. Follow a 2 part instruction.

Literacy – Make marks. Handle books carefully.

Fine motor skills – use one-handed tools.

Gross motor skills – Cross the midline. Put on own coat. Wash and dry hands.

Creative – draw to represent movement and noise. Sing songs. Draw faces.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development – Play with another child. Begin to talk about feelings.
